This Privacy Policy (the "Policy") applies to personal information provided or collected while using the easy-peasy online properties, including our <u>website</u> and our social media pages or handles (together, the "Services") operated by Garan, Incorporated. This Policy also applies anywhere it is linked. It does not apply to third-party websites, mobile applications, or services that may link to the Services or be linked from the Services. If we make changes to this Policy, such changes will be posted in this document on our website. We may change, modify, add, or remove portions of this policy at any time, and any changes will become effective immediately upon being posted unless stated otherwise.

1. What information does easy-peasy collect?

We collect information from you directly, from the devices you use to interact with us, and from third parties. We may combine information from the Services together and with other information we obtain from our business records. We may use and share information that we aggregate (compile to create statistics that cannot identify a particular individual) or de-identify (strip information of all unique identifiers such that it cannot be linked to a particular individual) at our discretion.

Information you provide to us

- Contact information, including name, email address, telephone number, and address.
- Content you may include in survey responses.
- Information contained in your communications to us, including call recordings of customer service calls.

- Diagnostic information, including web traffic logs.

We may use the information we collect from you for the following purposes. Our lawful bases of processing for each of these uses may be consent, our legitimate interests, or to comply with applicable law.

- Service improvement: To improve and grow our Services, including to develop new products and services and understand how our Services are being used, our customer base and purchasing trends, and the effectiveness of our marketing.
